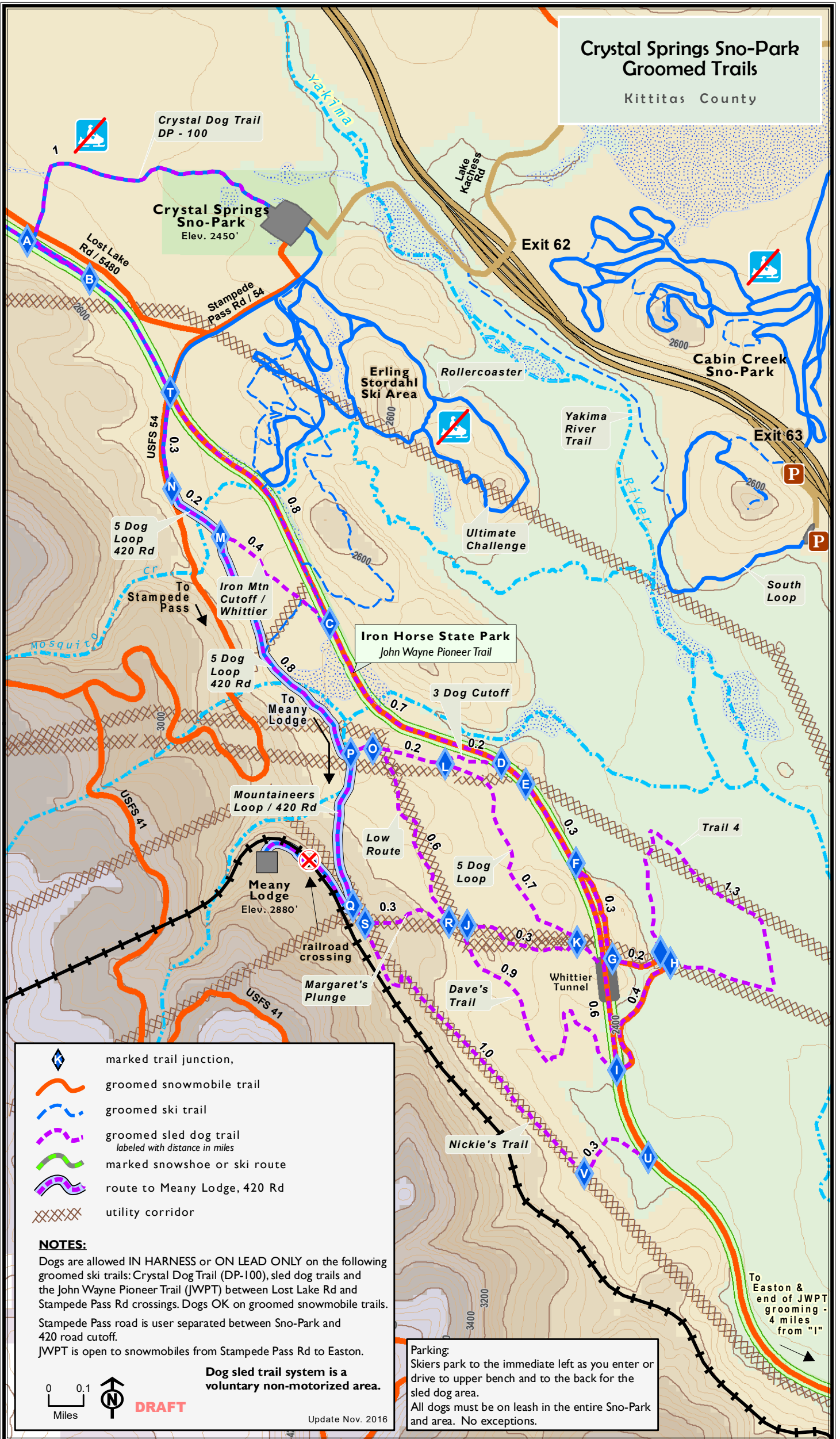

NOTES:

Dogs are allowed **IN HARNESS** or **ON LEAD ONLY** on the following groomed ski trails: Crystal Dog Trail (DP-100), sled dog trails and the John Wayne Pioneer Trail (JWPT) between Lost Lake Rd and Stampede Pass Rd crossings. Dogs OK on groomed snowmobile trails. Stampede Pass road is user separated between Sno-Park and 420 road cutoff. JWPT is open to snowmobiles from Stampede Pass Rd to Easton.

Dog sled trail system is a voluntary non-motorized area.

Parking:
Skiers park to the immediate left as you enter or drive to upper bench and to the back for the sled dog area. All dogs must be on leash in the entire Sno-Park and area. No exceptions.
